### AGE DIVISIONS:

A player's age as of January 1, 2010 determines the player is eligible to compete in the same year:

Ages 14 & Under	Ages 15-19
Singles	Singles
5-Person Teams	5-Person Teams

### FORMAT:

The District (State) tournaments will consist of Singles Girls and Open Division and 5-person teams in two (2) Divisions: Ages 14 & Under and Ages 15-19. In the singles event, three (3) games will be bowled to determine advancement. In the team event, two (2) games of regular 10-pin bowling will be followed by 5 games of Baker Team Competition to determine advancement. This is a scratch tournament and only actual scores are used. There is no carry-over of scores from District (State) to National Championships. Bowlers in the Ages 14 & Under Division may bowl up to the Ages 15-19 Division in either respective division and girls may bowl in a boys division; however, once they bowl up in one division, they must bowl up in all divisions in which they attempt to qualify.

### DISTRICT QUALIFYING ADVANCEMENT:

District (State) Team Advancement - At the District (State) Level, the top three teams in each division will advance to the AAU National JRO Games National Team Competition to be held in Virginia Beach, VA on July 31 through August 2, 2010.

District (State) Singles Advancement - At the District (State) Level, the top 10 individuals in each division will advance to the AAU National JRO Games Singles Competition to be held in Virginia Beach, VA on August 2 and 3, 2010.

The top 3 qualifying teams in each division and the top 10 qualifying singles in each division will have their entry fee to the AAU National JRO Games in Virginia Beach, VA paid for by the Bowling Centers Association of Michigan. All personal travel and lodging will be the responsibility of the athletes.
