The Bowl Swami is donating \$500.00 toward the “SMART” Essay & Bowling Scholarship concept. Scholarships may be awarded to any High School Student/Athlete participating in either the Bowl Swami Singles or the Michigan All Star competitions on June 21st who meet the following criteria:

1. Student/Athlete must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
2. Student/Athlete must complete an essay (SEE BELOW).
3. Student/Athlete must compete in either the Bowl Swami Singles or the Michigan All Star competition.

(5) \$100.00 Scholarships will be awarded as follows:

1. Top essay (as selected from the Bowl Swami “SMART” Committee)
2. Highest 4 Game Boys Qualifier in Bowl Swami Singles (**SMART** Entrant)
3. Highest 4 Game Girls Qualifier in Bowl Swami Singles (**SMART** Entrant)
4. Highest 6 Game Boys Qualifier in Michigan All Star (**SMART** Entrant)
5. Highest 6 Game Girls Qualifier in Michigan All Star (**SMART** Entrant)

Additional \$100.00 Scholarships will be awarded based on entries and funds accumulated from the events.

Bowl Swami Singles Bowling Format

June 21, 2008

Registration at 12:15 P.M.

1. There will be two divisions, one for Boys and one for Girls.
2. This Tournament will be a Singles Event.
3. Lane assignments will be pre-assigned by the tournament committee prior to check-in.
4. At 12:45 P.M. a 15 minute practice session will begin.
5. Athletes will then bowl a four game *qualifier* across 8 lanes.
6. The competition will then be cut to the top 16 Individuals in each Division (or an appropriate number based on entries) after the four game qualifier.
7. There will be a 30 minute meal break after the qualifier.
8. After the meal break, a 10 minute practice session will begin.
9. The competition will then be seeded in matches utilizing the NCAA match-up format.
10. Next, the athletes will bowl head-to-head, Single Game matches until the field has been reduced to the final pair in each division. In the event of a tie, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.
11. Winner of the Final Match in each division will be declared a Bowl Swami Champion.
12. Bowling Awards will be presented immediately upon completion of both divisions.

Trophy: 1st and Runner-up in each Division
Medals: All Qualifiers for Match Play will receive medals.

Please check in at least 45 minutes before squad time.
Tardy bowlers will receive zero pins for frames missed.

Rules & Regulations

1. MHSAA, USBC, and MHSIBCA rules and regulations will govern this tournament.
2. This event is open to all current high school athletes, grades 9-11, who participated on a Varsity or Junior Varsity Bowling Team in High School Competition.
3. There will be separate divisions for Boys and Girls.
5. ENTRY FEES: A fee of \$20.00 (or **\$25.00**) **must** accompany the entry. **No refunds will be issued.** Checks returned for insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. Include **\$5.00** if entering **SMART** Scholar optional.
6. All bowlers shall bowl scratch (no handicap).
7. All bowlers will be required to sign score sheets. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Director immediately. Any changes in scoring can only be made by the tournament management.
8. Awards will be given to the ALL QUALIFIERS IN EACH DIVISION.
9. All equipment used in the tournament must meet USBC specifications. Illegal equipment will constitute a forfeit and scores for that event shall be disallowed.
12. **Bowling Attire:** All bowlers should be dressed in appropriate attire. No hats, tank tops, shorts, tattered jeans or obscene clothing is allowed.
13. Only registered bowlers will be allowed in the immediate bowling area. All others must stay in spectator area.
14. Tardy bowlers: Bowling shall begin in accordance with a previously arranged schedule, unless the tournament manager authorizes a delay. Any player arriving late shall begin play with the score counting beginning with the frame and game then being bowled. All frames missed will be assessed zero points.
15. No tobacco products, drinking of alcoholic beverages or unsportsmanlike conduct will be permitted while participating in the event. Outside food or drinks are **NOT** allowed to be brought into the center. Bowlers will not be permitted the use of amusement games or pool tables during their team's competition.
16. Any disputes during the tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations will be resolved at the discretion of the tournament manager and/or the tournament committee.
17. The decision of the Tournament Management is final.
