GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2008 Michigan Junior Varsity Championship is hosted by Farmington Hills Mercy, Livonia Ladywood, Sterling Heights Utica Ford II, and Sterling Heights Utica Stevenson High Schools. It is being held at Sunnybrook Lanes on Saturday, February 16 (Singles) and Sunday, February 17 (Team). The following information should make your participation in the tournament easier.

Admission

There will be a \$5.00 admission for all spectators. A Two-Day Pass will be available for \$7.00 on Saturday. Similar to all MHSAA Tournaments, Administrators and Athletic Directors are asked to sign in and will enter without charge. **Please** inform your parents and others of this admission charge to avoid problems at the tournament. Coaches, please provide copies for athletes/parents.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the bowling center during a MHSAA contest.

Breakfast

A Continental Breakfast is provided for all Athletes and Coaches Registered.

Coaching Restrictions

One school coach **ONLY** will be allowed in the bowlers' seating area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Additional coaches must be in the spectator area. Coaching is only allowed between frames.

Disputes

In settling all disputes, the tournament directors will make all final decisions.

Dress Code

Athletes—Team Uniforms should be worn. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants should not be worn. A collared shirt should be worn. No hats, caps or any type of head gear should be worn. Coaches—All coaches should be in Team Uniform.

Format

Saturday Singles: Each bowler will bowl a three (3) game block across 6 lanes. The top 32 Boys and top 32 Girls will advance to the Match Play. The numbers for Match Play are based upon Entry numbers. In case of a tie for 32nd place, there will be a one (1) game roll off. Match Play will consist of one (1) Game Matches, winners advancing until the Round of Four. Winners from the Round of Four will bowl for the Championship and Losers of the Round of Four will bowl for 3rd and 4th Places.

Sunday Team: Each team will bowl five (5) Baker sets (2 games each set) across 10 lanes. The top 16 Boys Teams and 16 Girls Teams (Division 1) and 8 Girls Teams (Division 2) will advance to Match Play. In case of a tie for 16th Place, there will be a one (1) Baker Set Roll Off. Match Play will consist of Best Two of Three Baker Games (Total Pins do not Count), winners advancing until the Round of Four. Winners from the Round of Four will bowl for the Championship and Losers of the Round of Four will bowl for 3rd and 4th Places.

Lane Assignments

The Tournament Manager (Harry Burkey) will make the lane assignments by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will not be given out until the day of the tournament. Every effort will be made to keep Singles Bowlers of the same school within the same Block of Bowlers.

Lane Conditions

All competition lanes will be conditioned prior to the tournament and after Qualifying Rounds only if time permits. A copy of the lane dressing will be made available to coaches requesting.

Lunch

A Lunch is provided for all Athletes (whether they proceed to Match Play or not) and Coaches Registered.

Practice Prior to Tournament

Teams may contact Sunnybrook Lanes (Phone 586-264-2700) for practice **times and cost** for open bowling. **No practice** is allowed at Sunnybrook on tournament days **prior** to the start of each day.

Practice on Day of Tournament

There will be ten (10) minutes of practice prior to the start of SINGLES on Saturday and fifteen (15) minutes of practice prior to TEAM on Sunday.

Tournament Rules

The MHSAA Bowling Manual provides the guidelines. Two (2) balls allowed in the bowling area with only one allowed on the return rack. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the paddock area.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualification penalties, as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3, will be followed. Bowlers will not be allowed on the approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishment of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent lane approach to celebrate or "run-out" their delivery. Bowlers shall observe traditional bowling courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes. All bowlers should be seated and remain seated after their frames of delivery. Coaches should maintain a professional level of decorum at all times.
