Rules and Regulations

1. MHSAA rules and regulations govern this tournament.
2. This event is open to all current high schools that have a Varsity team in high school competition.
3. Entry fee is \$90 per team and must accompany the entry form. No refunds will be issued. Checks returned will be assessed a \$25 fee.
4. Check in officially starts at 11am. Officials will be available at 10:30am
5. ALL ENTRIES CLOSE AT 11:30 AM. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. All Coaches will be required to sign score sheets. Errors in reporting must be reported to the Tournament Manager. Any scoring changes can only be done by the Tournament Manager.
7. Awards will be given to the top two teams.
8. All equipment used in this tournament must meet USBC specifications.
9. USBC "White" oil pattern is being used.
10. Altering the surface of the ball is not permitted once it has been used in competition and shall result in disqualification. If a different ball is needed it may be altered only before it is used in competition.
11. Bowling Attire: All team members and coaches should be dressed alike in shirts and the same color. School shirts must reflect the name of the school and/or the school logo or mascot. Shorts and skirts will not be allowed. No hats allowed. Since this is an early tournament some leniency will be given by the Tournament Manager but if possible the requested attire should be followed.
12. Only registered team members and coaches will be allowed in the bowling level area.
13. Coaches are responsible for checking in their teams prior to competition.
14. Bowling shall begin at the designated time unless the Tournament Manager authorizes a delay. Any player or team arriving late shall be allowed to begin play but will be assessed a zero frame for all frames missed.
15. No tobacco products, consumption of alcoholic beverages or unsportsmanlike conduct will be permitted while participating in this event. Outside food or drinks are not permitted to be brought into the center. Bowlers will not be permitted the use of amusement games or pool tables during the team's competition.
16. Any disputes during the tournament or exceptions to the above rules and regulations will be resolved at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
17. The decision of the Tournament Manager is final.

Grand Ledge High School All Baker Tournament Format

1. The tournament is limited to 20 boys and 20 girls' teams. Each team will bowl a qualifying round of ten (1) baker games.
2. The field will be cut to the top 12 boys and 12 girls teams based on the total pins bowled during the 10 baker games. If there is a tie to determine the last place team, the team with highest baker game will advance.
3. Altering the surface of a bowling ball is not permitted once it has been used in competition. If a different ball is needed it may be altered only before it is used in competition.
4. Teams that start on the odd lane will move left after each baker game. Teams on the even move right. We will not be alternating lanes each frame.
5. No bowler can begin the next frame until the opponent they are bowling has completed their frame. For example: Bowler 1 on the left lane strikes. Bowler 1 on the right lane records a 9 pin count on the first ball. Bowler 1 on the right lane must be allowed to finish the frame before Bowler 2 on the left can bowl the second frame. Once Bowler 1 on the right starts to finish his or her frame then Bowler 2 on the left is permitted to bowl. This format is to be used throughout the tournament.
6. After the top 12 teams have been determined they will be divided into 2 divisions. The odd number teams will be in division 1 and the evens in division 2. Each team will bowl six (1) baker games match play style. Division 1 vs. Division 2, 30 points will be awarded to each winning team. In the event of a tie 15 points will be awarded.
7. Points from the qualifying round and the match play, including bonus points will be totaled to determine the top 2 teams in each division.
8. After the top 2 teams have been determined the teams will cross divisions and bowl 2 baker games against each other as shown below:
Division 1 first place team bowls the Division 2 second place team. Division 1 second place team bowls the Division 2 first place team.
Only the total pins for these 2 bakers decide who will bowl in the final.
9. Tie Breaker: An additional baker game will be bowled if time permits. If time permits and a tie continues then the highest baker game bowled in the previous 2 games will decide the winner. If there is not enough time then the highest baker game bowled in the 2 games will decide the winner.
10. An awards ceremony will be held immediately following the championship matches.
11. ALL bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn due to the limited amount of time to complete the tournament.
