Weekend updates will be done on a weekly basis during the high school bowling season.

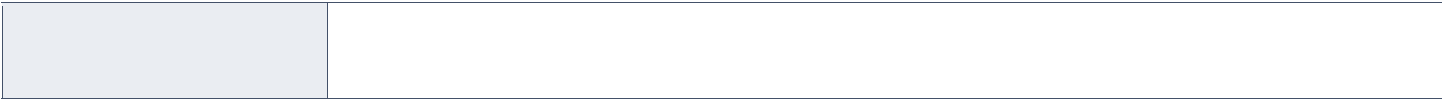
Congrats to Wyoming Kelloggsville Bowler Chelsey Purdum – 300 game!
