## **Possible Changes Coming For Bowling Next Year**

The MHSAA is discussing changes for next season which could include starting dates and changes to Regional and State Final competitions. Nothing has been changed yet but discussions will take place before next season. One of the big discussions will be making Regionals a 1 day event. Pressure from schools regarding lost school time, travel, expenses, etc. are part of this issue, as well as having access to 24 centers around the state for two days. If they shorten both the team and singles qualifying volume they should be able to do this. It also gives them more flexibility and less stress if we have bad weather. This would mean less games for both team and singles competition. The same thing is being discussed for State Finals, the MHSAA would like to cut at least an hour out of the team event, the only way to do this is to eliminate games somewhere. Sounds like they are going to stick with the Kegel Middle of The Road Pattern for at least 1 more year, but that will also be discussed. Just a reminder, this is all being discussed, it does not mean that things have been changed yet, but it is being looked at.
